Proposed Amendments to Existing Municipal Plan and Development Regulations for the Town of Grand Bank

Interested people are invited to review and comment on amendments proposed to be made to the Town's Municipal Plan and Development Regulations for 2012-2022.

The Municipal Plan identified a topic that called for remedy: the boundary of the municipal Planning Area was seen to be overly large. The Municipal Plan in Section 3.4 said in part: "*The Planning Area is far larger than just the area defined by the Town boundary. Indeed, it includes part of the area of the Local Service District of Grand Beach and that community's protected water supply area..."* Consequently, the Municipal Plan said that Council would strive to have the area reduced. The then Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment made an order to that effect on July 30, 2017, to reduce the municipal Planning Area as it involved Grand Beach as shown on the maps in the amending documents. Its eastern boundary at Grand Beach has been moved toward Famine Point and runs largely along Crouse East Brook. The amendments do not change the Town's municipal boundary.
